School Report: Julie Eadens, current President of Holy Name of Jesus Catholic School was in attendance and gave the report. Courage is the school motto this school year. The 6th, 7th and 8th grade have moved from the first floor to the second floor. The Early Learning Program for Preschool and Prekindergarten will be offering families a program that will be all year.

The rate will be \$130 per week and snacks and lunch are included. Monica Krampe has been hired as the 6th grade Math/Science teacher.
